VOLUNTEER CHECK LIST

Volunteers Assemble at 9am at GHS

- **Wear face covering (bridge of nose to under your chin)**
Please provide your own face mask!
- **Not have any symptoms of the Covid 19 virus**
- **Have their temperature checked before starting to serve** (we will provide the temp check on the parking lot).
Our threshold is 100.4
- **Practice 6' social distancing**
- **Be able to lift 10-15 lbs (weight of food boxes)**
- **Be on GHS parking lot at 9m**
- **Event ends at 12pm (volunteers are welcome to leave earlier than this time, but please be sure we have replacements)**
- **Dress Appropriately (we represent the Body of Christ)**
- **Bring your own food (lunch, snacks, waters etc.)**

- **Unloading boxes**
- **Loading boxes into vehicles**
- **Stocking box areas**
- **Collect data from recipients (recipients will have to remain in their vehicle. Volunteers will stay 6' away and ask that driver side window is slightly open for communication)**
- **Traffic control**
- **Staging coordinator**
- **Be part of distribution team (handing out boxes)**
 - **UNLOADING TEAM** (unloading trucks with food)
 - **MECHANIC TEAM** (assist if vehicle breaks down)
 - **FORKLIFT TEAM** (keeping vehicle and people safe as vehicle moves around lot)
 - **PALLET JACK TEAM** (putting food in locations)
 - **TRASH TEAM** (keeping lot free of trash)
 - **PARKING LOT STAGING TEAM** (lining vehicles up)
 - **PARKING LOT AMBASSADOR/GREETER** (directions on lot, to lanes, off lot)
 - **CARE TEAM** (nurse, doctor or pa preferred for this team please)
 - **NO DAYCARE AVAILABLE**, so parents must take full responsibility for their small children. A parking lot with moving vehicles can be dangerous
 - **ADMIN TEAM** (gathering data from participant will in staging areas)
